



Welcoming Committee Keeps Busy

It appears that the growth at Sun Valley Lake is continuing! Existing homes are being bought and additional new homes are permitted and ready to begin or are in the process of building. As a result, the Welcoming Committee has been keeping busy.

The goal of the Welcoming Committee is to greet and welcome new homeowners to the lake. Ringgold County sends new deeds to the SVILA office. They forward the deeds to me. I then go on Beacon to determine if it's a home or a lot that was purchased. We put together a welcome bag which is an insulated bag and includes an information packet, a beach towel with the Sun Valley logo, and advertisements and gift items from various businesses in the community. Then we're ready to deliver the bags to new homeowners.

From June 2021 to present we have delivered 25 Welcome Bags to new homeowners. In addition, there were 11 lot sales.

An information packet is mailed to each new lot owner, with the plan to deliver a welcome bag once their house is built and they have moved in. We recently obtained the building permits from the SVILA office. We'll keep an eye open for when those homes are built, and folks move in. We'd like those new homeowners to get a Welcome Bag as well.

We've been hiring additional support staff for both Office and Grounds work in the last couple of months. Road Safety and Repairs

We've also hired a new Lake Patrol Staff member, Brenna Young. Brenna will be working throughout our primary lake and boating season to demonstrate and reinforce safe boating practices and enforce our SVILA Boating rules.

Along with Boating safety, the Association will be enhancing our road safety program this season. With plans to invest another significant amount towards road repair and resurfacing, we're looking to improve roads that are still structurally sound, with work likely to begin at or around the time this article is published. Better roads should enhance safer use by all members. Additionally, the Association will work to regularly remind and advise all members and guests about posted speed limits and rules concerning off-road vehicle use. We want every member and their guests to have a fun and safe experience while at Sun Valley.

Volunteer Committees

At the May Board meeting, Paul Jones mentioned volunteerism and the benefits all of us enjoy, based on the efforts of our volunteers. As the newest Lake Manager, I want to reiterate that statement of appreciation. Every day since starting full time, I see conscientious, unpaid, hard-working men and women giving their time and talents to make Sun Valley Lake better. From welcoming newcomers, planting flowers, inspecting building sites, monitoring water quality and more. MEET CAPTAIN YOUNG, LAKE PATROL



My name is Brenna Young, but when you see me on the lake you can call me Captain Young. I am a USCG Captain trained by Captain Ted on Lake Superior in Minnesota. College was a lot a work; going to class to learn the navigation rules, plus the other classes I had to do was a lot of time. I have been trained on lakes, the Gulf of Mexico, and the Atlantic Ocean. It has been fun learning about the water.

The reason I got the license in the first place is because I started a small business called Captain Young Travels. People hire

me to take them out on a tour so they can enjoy the lake without worrying about driving the boat. I do this here in Iowa during the summer, then I live in sunny Florida for the winter and take people on tours on the Gulf. I also do hands on training for new boaters to learn the basics of boat safety, basic docking, and anchoring classes. I show them how to work their boat, take them out and teach them boat etiquette while on the lake. You have certified hours on the water if you want to get your USCG license.

My family has owned a house here on the lake since 2012. We have noticed how it is getting busier on the water. I have changed a lot in my life, deciding to stay away from corporate world, and start working for myself. I have open time on the weekends, so when I found out the Lake Patrol job was open, I thought this was perfect for me. It's flexible, plus I want to keep the water safe so no one will get hurt on the water or sink their boat.

Gene and I have been making a schedule as to when we will be out patrolling. You will see us out a lot more -- morning, afternoons, and after sunset. There are times like Memorial weekend when it was too windy to be out as much as I wanted to be. We need to be safe while on the water; when the winds are 35-40 miles per hour we may not be out as much, but trust me, it does not mean I won't be out at all. I will get the boat out for a little while to make sure everyone else is safe when the conditions are like that.

I take safety seriously, but I need your help as well. What I noticed so far is when I am out the boats go to the opposite side where I am. Then I go to the other side and magically they are on the opposite side of me again! If you do see something, please **text** the Lake Patrol cell 641-464-5350; don't call because I may be driving the boat or pulling someone at the time, but I will see the text. Tell me the type of boat or jet ski and where they are heading. Don't forget to tell me what they are doing or what rule they are breaking. I will pull them over. This will be helpful for me so I can keep this lake safe.

Know that Gene, the lake manager, and I, plus any other staff we have this summer will work hard to keep us all safe. With your help and our training, I believe you will see less and less problems. Let's work together to keep this great lake safe. Let's have a safe summer at Sun Valley Lake!




